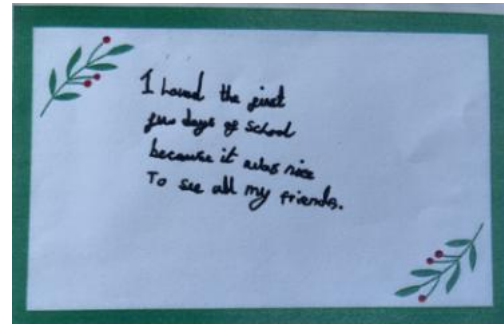
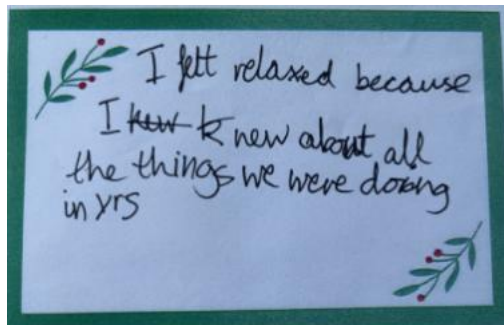
In English, we have launched our exciting new writing unit based on The Lost Thing. The children have been exploring a range of grammatical techniques to enrich their writing and have even begun designing their very own “lost thing” ready for some ambitious descriptive work next week. Their creativity has been brilliant to see.

Our science lessons have been full of curiosity and investigation. Year 5 carried out an experiment exploring solubility, testing different substances, making predictions, and carefully writing up their findings. The children showed excellent scientific thinking and worked safely and sensibly throughout.

We have also enjoyed another week of swimming, where the children continue to represent our school beautifully. They have shown resilience, encouragement as well as already making great progress in the pool.

Finally, we continue to enjoy sharing our whole-class novel, *Who Let the Gods Out?*, reading together every day and diving deeper into the characters, humour and mythology. This also links nicely into our history unit on the Ancient Greeks.
