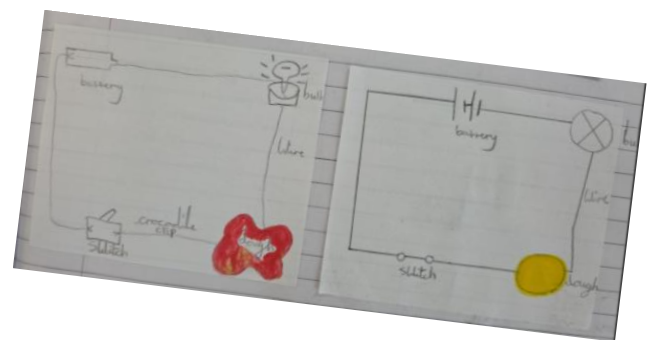
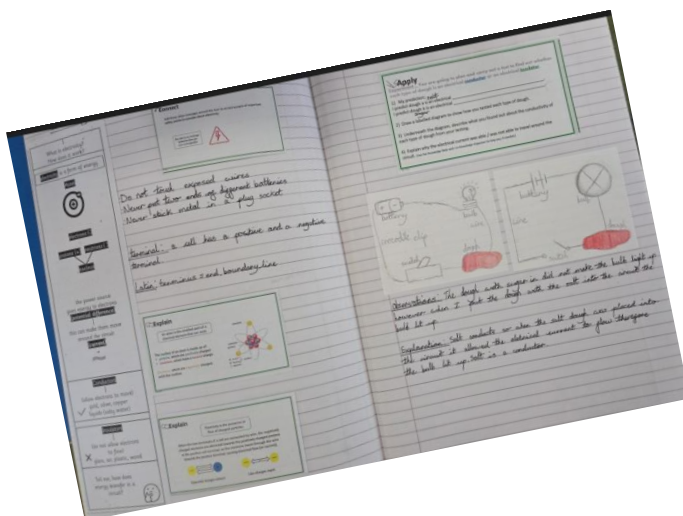
Church Langton Church of England Primary School Newsletter – Updates and Announcements
