The School Day

The gates will open at 8.40am each day. Registration will be taken at 8.55am. If you arrive after this time, you will need to sign your child/children into school using our Invenry IT system in the office reception area. Between 8.40-8.55am retrieval activities are available in every classroom, prompt arrival is encouraged to maximise learning opportunities. Mr Baylis or I will be available on the playground at the start of each day to welcome you and answer any questions.

On the first day back, the children will be greeted by their teachers at their classroom doors or on the playground (Y4/5), where they will be asked to line up. They will be taken inside together at 8.55am.

Everyday thereafter, the children will enter their classroom when they arrive.

The children have a 15-minute morning break at 10.15am, daily, and lunchtime is 12-1pm. The school day ends at 3.15pm and the gates will be open from 3.10pm. Mr Baylis or I will be available on the playground at the end of each day, as well as the class teachers, to answer any questions.

Welcome meetings

Wrap Around Care

This provision will start on Tuesday 27th August. Breakfast club opens at 7.45am, in The Langton Community Hall. After-school club will run from 3.15-5.15 (two, 1 hour sessions). All sessions are bookable on Arbor at £6.50 each. We have limited spaces (30) and **booking is essential**. Arbor App – personal details

Please could you take 2 minutes to check that the information on your app is up to date. We require at least two contacts, in case of emergency, and all medical information. It is also useful to add any additional adults that you authorise to collect your child/children (grandparents, relatives, friends). Although you can call the office to advise if someone different is collecting at the end of the day, by adding others on Arbor we can verify their identity quickly and satisfy our safeguarding procedures, ensuring we have the safety of the children at the heart of our practice.

You will have received information on Friday regarding the new booking/payment system, Mrs Lykholat will be able to offer additional support on our return to school.

Medication in School

If your child requires regular medication in school (inhalers etc.) please can you place them in a clear labelled bag/box with your child's name and ideally a photograph, also please check that all medication is in date. You will need to complete a new form in the office for us to administer any medication in school. Any ad hoc medication (e.g. Calpol/anti-biotics) must also come into school via the office and signed consent given. Please can you speak to me directly if your child has an EpiPen in school.

Packed lunches and Snacks

Please remember we are a strictly **NUT FREE** school - this includes in spreads and bars. All breaktime snacks must be healthy, this supports our health promoting school agenda. Please provide a drink each day, we would encourage water only. If your child will not drink water, the only permitted alternative is cordial. Fizzy/energy drinks are not permitted in school and will be returned home.
